## Regular Meeting 2024-09-14 Minutes

14:00 Michael calls meeting to order.

## **Old Business**

- 1) Are there any errors or omissions in previous minutes (posted on the website)? **No issues.**
- 2) Mark raised the question if the minutes needed to be posted on the website. Members responded with a yes that they wanted them to be posted.

## **New Business**

- Trial mid-summer meeting seems successful. Executive members suggested we go to a full twelve month schedule in the future. One member stated that he prefers the summer off and suggested we return to 10 meetings per year with no meetings during the summer. A number of members supported that. A vote was taken and a strong majority agreed. Michael accepted the majority opinion and cancelled next summer's July meeting. Later in the proceedings, it was suggested that a three month lay-off before the 50th anniversary meeting could possibly have a detrimental affect on the organization of the event. Is further discussion warranted?
- 2) Further update of the 50th anniversary celebration:
  - BNAP scheduling update. The 2025 BNAP event is now scheduled to fall on the same weekend as the Vernon 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary event. The members felt that this would not present a problem. Michael suggested that the Vernon event may in fact benefit from the visiting dealers and delegates, and that we may see a few out-of-towners attending our meeting. Regardless, the length of the BNAP event (3 days) will give everybody the chance to attend both.
  - idea of a written program which would be a "keepsake" of the event as well as a vehicle for

acknowledging supporting institutions/businesses (The People Place, Morningstar, Weeda Stamps, Co-Op & Staples) - now Safeway being the latest to step up. The members had little feedback on the concept and when Michael polled the attendees for a volunteer to champion the project, no one stepped-up.

- Display contest has Barrie Lockton amassing 12 frames & 6 double sided easels with five frames spoken for to date. The members in attendance were quite impressed by Barrie's sample frame (introduced during Barrie's Bytes). Mark volunteered to prepare a frame.
- 3) OMPA/OSC wants content from the three member clubs. Is anyone interested in taking up the torch on our behalf? **None of the members volunteered.**
